ASSESSOR – Melissa Griffin

Missy is currently looking at leasing or purchasing a new copier and plotter for her office. A copy of the proposed lease/contract was given to County attorney, Kent Minnette for his review.

SHERIFF

There are currently 71 inmates at the Jail. Thirty eight are Fountain County, 11 DOC holds and 22 from Sullivan County. There are 58 males and 13 females.

The jail sewer project was discussed. Tim Shumaker stated that most of the waste was chip and candy wrappers. He suggested they may want to get rid of the Commissary to help alleviate the problem. Roger Azar asked about re-bidding the project again. The Commissioners wish to re-bid the project. Roger and Kent will work on getting the notice ready.

HIGHWAY – Jason Lewis

Jason stated the striping was delayed but Milestone was to do it today. He is waiting on an estimate from TNT Concrete to repair a culvert that is in need of repair along this same road. Jason invited the Commissioners to the Council meeting to hear a presentation from Vialytics on Monday.

CUSTODIAN

The four-wheeler from the Courthouse was loaned to the EMS department some time ago. Rick would like to have it back so that he can clear the Courthouse sidewalks when needed. Smarts will do the clearing of snow over 2 inches. No motion was made but was decided to have Garth bring it back to the Courthouse.

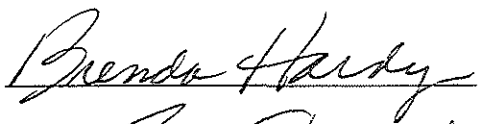
COUNCIL – Jeff Fishero
