**DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS**

**Highway – Rusty Peevler**  
Chip and Seal was done all the way down Dixie Bee. They opened Meridian today. Bridge #10 was done and they are waiting on VS Engineering to sign off on it. Bridge #25 & #30 need steel beams.  
The truck that was ordered in February has still not been delivered. It is in Illinois. They will be checking in on it to see when it can be delivered.

**Ambulance – Garth Kagels**  
Garth’s Vehicle is a 2008 and the PCN went out on it. They have opted to replace the vehicle. The commissioners have requested that he have all the estimated quotes laid out with the estimated time frame of being ready. He does not have to wait until the next meeting to discuss the cost of the truck.

The commissioners agreed to allow Garth to hire someone to replace the employee that resigned.

The plumbing in the EMS building needs to be addressed. There was a near accident again when the line got clogged. The determination of what the issue is that the toilets need to be replaced. They do not have enough force to push things through. They are estimated at \$300 each to get a better water flow. Matt Johnson from Johnson Sewer Service is who Garth has been receiving service to the building from. More estimates will be gotten for the purchase of toilets and a decision to be made on how to handle the issue.

**Health Dept. – Erich Haley**

The house on Osborn/Prairie Rd had been condemned. A couple was going to rent the property and brought in 3 dumpsters to clean up the house and the property. It looks much better and the health department has taken it out of Condemned status.

**Landfill – Greg Robison**

He reported the packing down and hauling of dirt to compact the dirt at the Landfill.
