DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Highway - Rusty Peevler

There are some issues at the Highway, main one being water in the gas tanks. That is being addressed. Also, the credit card is blocked with an outstanding fee of \$13.00. Colleen Chambers will be calling after the meeting to get it straightened out. Also, they have never had an assistant to the superintendent. He would like to make Travis Covault his Assistant.

A motion was made by Tim Shumaker and seconded by Andrew Hall to approve the position and appoint Travis Covault to Assistant Superintendent. Vote: 3-0

The handbook says that highway employees will not receive overtime if called out to work holidays or weekends. The Salary Ordinance says differently. The County Attorney and the Commissioners both agree that the handbook needs to be reevaluated.

Tim Shumaker asked why the Highway employees no longer get to take their trucks home. It was decided in past year that it was more cost effective to not take them home. It has been found that it is not the case and they should take them home to optimize the work day.

Ambulance - Garth Kagels

316 runs last month. Highest ever. The 2018 Ford F-450 Ambulance has been in the shop and they found that the O2 ports are leaking and lines have a hole in them. The truck needs to go back the manufacturer to get it fixed.

Sheriff – Terry Holt

They are housing several inmates from Sullivan County.

The generator is still not working properly and DLZ has been contacted many times on the issue. They finally are sending out a technician. Evapar actually installed the generator.

Old Jail needs to have the lines flushed before they freeze. They need to find out if the old stainless-steel appliances that were damaged can be auctioned/sold. Kent Minnette stated we should get something in writing before we dispose of the appliances.

Clerk - Paula Copenhaver

The County received the grant for reimbursement of extra funds spent during election through the COVID Pandemic. It was for just over \$10,000.

Judge - Stephanie Campbell

She came to the Commissioners and asked for permission to hire a new employee to be the Administrator for the Clinical Addiction Program. Her office would be at the New Jail. Kaela Allen is who they would like to hire.

Maintenance - Rick Beck

Heating/ Cooling is on its last leg and needs to have a decision made on what steps are next to improve the heating/cooling in the building.

Coroner - Josh Whittington

Last year there were 30+ pickups, more than usual. More transports and calls. COVID did not have any bearing on this. There was only 1 confirmed COVID death. He will need an additional appropriation this year for slide boards for the 3-piece shelf unit. That will make the bodies easier to be moved in the cooler. He will be bringing quotes to the February meeting.

Auditor - Colleen Chambers

Human Resources / Payroll needs to be more private. To remedy that, she would like to purchase dividers to put around their desk. Also, she would like to purchase a new desk for her deputies in the office. The Commissioners agreed for her to go ahead with the purchase.
