PUBLIC COMMENT

Jason Lave

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Ambulance - Garth Kagels

They are having issues with drainage again. There is 3 lines coming into 1. There were new toilets installed and the problem still persists. The pipes are all under concrete. Roger Azar said he would be able to come and take a look at the situation.

The FG Grant has been pushed back until January 18, 2022. This grant is to hopefully fund the Power Load System Cots for the Ambulances. There have not been any bids on the Military Ambulance. He requested to put it on ambulancetrader.com.

ORDINANCE 2021-17

Redistricting

The precincts were redrawn.

A motion was made by Andrew Hall and seconded by Tim Shumaker to accepting the new Ordinance 2021-17 establishing Council and Commissioner precincts. Vote:3-0

Highway - Rusty Peevler

Their charting system is outdated and can no longer be updated properly. He would like to order 2 new graders from John Deere. In order to get it at the 7.5% savings, it will need to be in writing. \$55,680 FOR EACH GRADER

A motion was made by Andrew Hall and seconded by Tim Shumaker approved Rusty Peevler to proceed with the lease of the 2 graders from John Deere.

Vote: 3-0

Bridge #97 needs to be completed. He would like to have Roger Azar look at it and see what all needs to be done.

A motion was made by Andrew Hall and seconded by Tim Shumaker to give permission to Roger Azar to assist the County Highway on what needs to be done to Bridge #97.

Vote: 3-0

A separate area is needed for the Highway Secretary. It is not good conditions to work in since there isn't a proper ventilation system. It has been recommended to put a "SheShed" next to the Highway Building. It is a 12x20 building for \$12,000. Council members have visited the Highway Department and wrote letters to Dudley stating that they can taste fuel when they go in there and that it is not an environment that the secretary or anyone should work in.

The Commissioners and Council are in favor of purchasing the building.

Roger Azar – Maple Corner Phase I – Maple Corner

The building looks good so far. There does seem to be some sewer issues. He would like to contact a company out of Crawfordsville to look at the possible issues. The commissioners agreed.

Andrew Hall said that both appraisals were completed and he was awaiting the paperwork on them.

Tuggle Drain

Mr. Tuggle is wanting to know the status of the Tuggle Drain. Kent Minnette, County Attorney, suggested at the 2nd meeting of the New Year, to discuss the process to finish the project.

Greg Robison - Landfill

There is some damage out at the Landfill that will have to be repaired. Darrell Bell and Roger Azar came out to the Landfill to assess the damage and agree. There are plenty of funds to repairs the damages.

Brenda Hardy - READI Grant

30 million was awarded to the area. The governing board will decide which projects will be approved.

LPA USI Consulting Contract - May 1st, 2022 - April 30, 2025

Brenda Hardy brought forth this contract to be approved.

A motion was made by Andrew Hall and seconded by Tim Shumaker to approve the Contract with USI Consultants. Vote: 3-0

Jail Surplus

A motion was made by Tim Shumaker and seconded by Andrew Hall to declare the Jail kitchen equipment as surplus and donate it to the Fountain County 4H council at the fairgrounds.
